In the next few weeks (March 1 – 10) your fire department will be receiving a fire station information request from Explore Information Services, L.L.C. Explore is under contract (per Federal Contract #NIMA30103C0006) with the National Geo-Spatial Intelligence Agency (NGA) to develop and maintain a National Fire Station Database as part of the Department of Homeland Security (DHS) Geospatial Infrastructure Contract.

This is an important effort, providing critical infrastructure and response information to the NGA/Dept. of Homeland Security.
